Research and Evaluation

- Statewide Surveys
 - LGBTQ+ Data Practices Survey
 - The survey has closed, with interviews being conducted with a subset of practitioners. A report of the findings is forthcoming in spring 2024.
 - The College Attendance Survey
 - The statewide report of the findings will be forthcoming by early spring 2024.
 - Allied Health Survey
 - The survey will be live until December 15th.

 - A new report was released based on findings from a statewide survey of African American/Black transfer students' experiences.
