

ASCCC Event Modality Survey - Initial Report

Data as of August 18, 2023

Background

In response to Resolution Spr23 01.04 - Attendees' Preferences and ASCCC's Feasibility, ASCCC staff developed an Event Modality Survey and distributed it to the field on August 1, 2023. The survey questions sought to identify participants' attendance at various events in 2022 and 2023 to-date, motivations for their decision to attend or not, and how certain modalities would impact their decision to attend future events.

Overview

The survey contained 34 questions and yielded 289 responses as of this report. Questions 1 through 10 pertained to respondent demographics and Questions 11 through 34 focused on various ASCCC events, in-person and virtual attendance, factors that influenced past attendance and would likely influence future participation. Approximately 87.19% of respondents are full-time faculty members and 12.81% are part-time. 67.97% of respondents identify as White; 15.66% identify as Mexican, Mexican American, or Chicano; 8.9% identify as Black; and the remaining 7.47% identify as one of 15 other race options.


The 2022 events included in the survey were Curriculum Institute, Spring Plenary Session, Fall Plenary Session, Faculty Leadership Institute, and Career and Noncredit Institute. In addition to these events, participants were asked about virtual participation in the Accreditation Institute, Part-Time Faculty Institute, and CalOER Conference. Each of these events had varied in-person vs virtual attendance and some respondents attended multiple events. The 2023 events included Curriculum Institute, Spring Plenary Session, and Faculty Leadership Institute.

Respondents indicated a variety of motivating factors that determined if and how they would participate in a given ASCCC event. Factors included (but were not limited to) the topic of the event or individual breakout sessions, cost of registration or accommodations, networking opportunities, and timing of the event.

Lastly, respondents were asked about the likelihood they would participate in future ASCCC events if they were offered in-person, virtually, or as a hybrid model. They were also asked if they would participate in specified events if they were only offered as a virtual event.

ASCCC is currently awaiting additional responses and conducting analysis of the data collected to provide insights on future event offerings.


Q1 Are you Hispanic or Latino (Check one)



Q3 What sex were you assigned at birth?



Q4 What is your current gender identity?




Q5 What is your sexual orientation?


Q6 What is your employment status?


Q7 Which of the following best describes your role at your college? (You may select multiple)


Q8 What is your gross annual income (before taxes and deductions) for all of your teaching faculty positions combined?

Q9 Do you consider yourself differently abled?





Q11 In 2022, which of the following events did you attend in person?




Q12 In 2022, which of the following events did you attend only using the online platform?


Q13 Was this your first time attending any of these events?

Q14 Which of the following events did you attend for the first time?




Q15 In 2023, which of the following events did you attend in person?

Q16 How did you hear about the event?






Q20 In 2023, which of the following events did you attend online only?

Q21 What factors informed your decision to attend virtually?




Q22 In 2023, was it your first time attending any of the following events?

Q23 What factors informed your decision to not attend the events?



Q24 Does your college provide any financial support to attend ASCCC events?






Q26 Select the modality that you would most likely utilize to attend future events.





Q27 Select all the factors you consider when deciding which modality to use to attend events?



Q28 If Academic Academy became a virtual only event, would you attend?



Q30 If the Part-Time Faculty Institute became a virtual only event, would you attend?


