

Hello colleagues-

Thank you for your patience in receiving this most recent update from the Guided Pathways Task Force. The listservs across the system were impacted much of February, but we are back up (and at it all!)

The CCCCCO Guided Pathways Multi-Year Work Plan is due on March 30th, 2018. In completing the workplan, California community colleges throughout the system must consider areas of focus and fiscal allocations for local guided pathways efforts and present general task areas in the work plan to be eligible for funding. The Multi-Year Work Plans must be signed off on by the local campus Chief Executive Officer and the Academic Senate President and is intended to be a “living” document that may be adjusted over time to ensure a realistic implementation.

Here are some ideas for consideration:

- ✓ Take the time to think and plan – it is fine to spend this next year in planning rather than doing (or, more likely, a combination of planning and doing).
- ✓ Ensure that the faculty and academic senate are at the table at every step, that a good relationship is established at the very beginning so that when all stakeholders are at the table the unique role of the faculty will be recognized.
- ✓ Work toward a plan that is fully grounded in your college’s vision, mission, and culture
- ✓ Build the plan with existing strategic planning procedures and evaluate the plan with existing mechanisms
- ✓ Dream without restrictions and edit/be practical later. This should be a creative process.
- ✓ Realize that this is a long-term project, not one that must be accomplished today.
