 - Emphasis on resources that will increase OER adoption (resources must be tied to a specific course or courses)
 - Collaboration required
 - Two-step process "letter of intent to submit" (LOI) required in order to respond to RFP
 - Support provided to LOI submitters
 - o ~ 167 LOIs received
 - ~ 61 RFP submissions to be reviewed January 14-15
