BACKGROUND:

At the last Consultation Council meeting, the ASCCC, Chancellor’s Office, Chief Instructional Officers, Chief Student Services Officers, Student Senate and the Faculty Association of California Community Colleges formed a workgroup to collectively address the safety and security needs of our students, especially those who may be most vulnerable as new policies and laws are enacted by the federal government in 2017. Specific information about the workgroup is included on the attachment.

The Executive Committee will discuss the formation of this workgroup, its purpose, and the participation of the ASCCC. Discussion will include a process for identifying resources to be approved and disseminated by the organizations participating in the workgroup as well as a process for identifying, housing, and disseminating resources to be shared with local senates and faculty.
