
## **C-ID** AND CTE PROCESS

FACULTY

Faculty register to attend the DIG meeting, bringing with them materials from their local college and industry feedback to review with colleagues during the meeting.

## DISCIPLINE INPUT GROUP (DIG) MEETING

Industry input is provided by the SN/DSNs and through the survey

Faculty develop model curriculum & descriptors

## After meeting:

Faculty discipline review group (FDRG) is convened for the discipline. The group reviews and finalizes drafts of model curriculum and descriptors for statewide vetting.

FDRG reviews vetted materials and finalizes documents.

Industry partners, faculty, articulation officers, and other interested parties, are asked to provide input on the draft documents.
